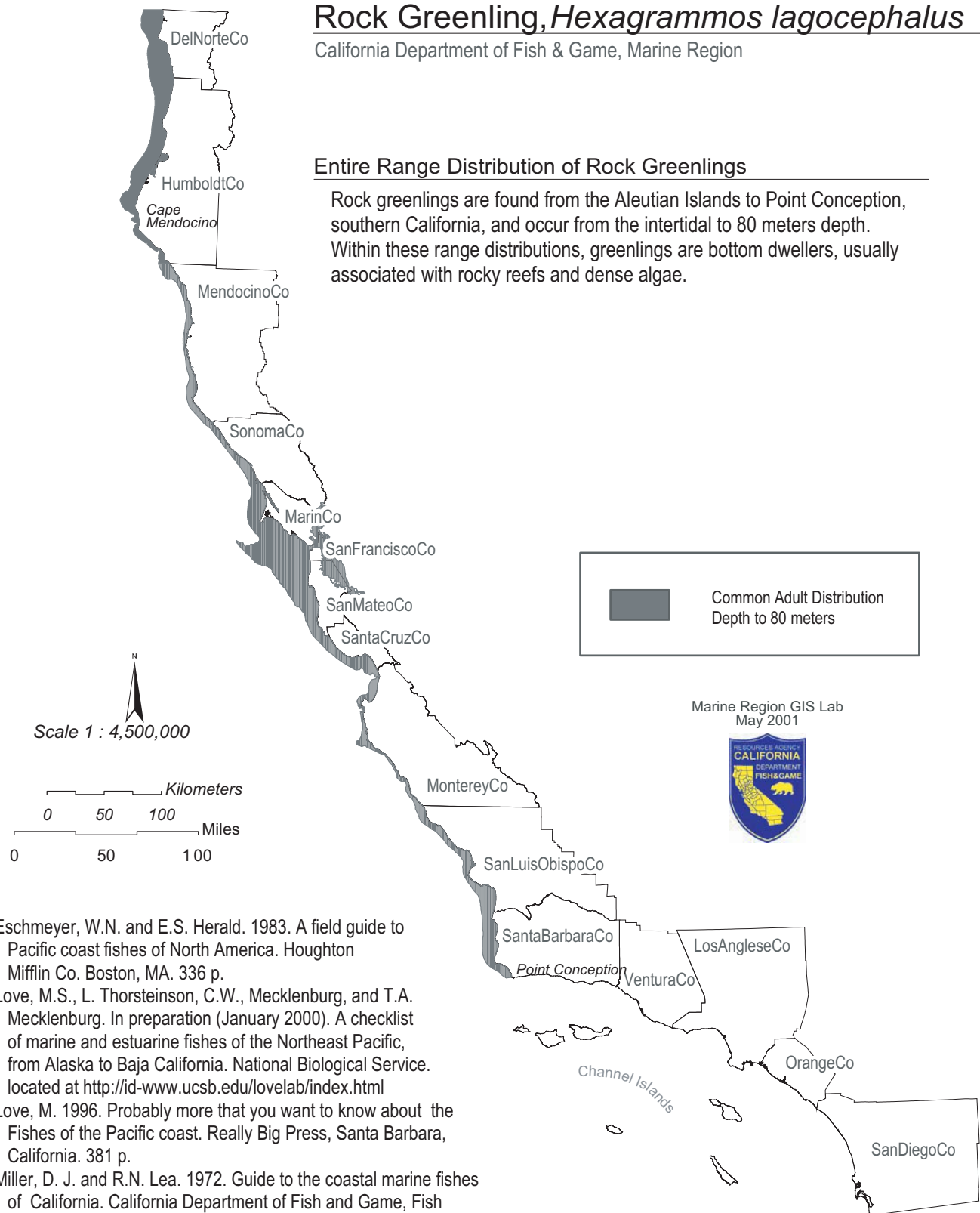


Rock Greenling, *Hexagrammos lagocephalus*

Entire Range Distribution of Rock Greenlings

Rock greenlings are found from the Aleutian Islands to Point Conception, southern California, and occur from the intertidal to 80 meters depth. Within these range distributions, greenlings are bottom dwellers, usually associated with rocky reefs and dense algae.
