Background

Committee Work Plan

Topics that have been referred by the Commission to WRC are displayed within a work plan for scheduling and tracking. The updated work plan in Exhibit 1 includes proposed topics for January 2026, including one potential new topic.

Potential New Topic

The Department proposes that the regulatory topic "Mammal Trapping" be referred to WRC for initial vetting and discussion in January and discussion with a potential recommendation in May 2026. Several trapping rules in California Fish and Game Code have changed over the last few years, necessitating corresponding changes in Title 14. The topic has been added to the draft work plan in blue text to represent that it is new/proposed.

Next Committee Meeting

The next committee meeting is scheduled for January 13, 2026 in Sacramento, with a webinar option for the public. In addition to standing agenda items (Department updates and future agenda items), four topics are proposed:

- Inland sport fishing. Discussion and potential recommendation for Departmentrecommended regulatory amendments related to inland sport fishing.
- Commercial use of rattlesnakes. Discussion and potential recommendations for Department-recommended regulations regarding the commercial use of native rattlesnakes.
- Mammal trapping. Initial vetting and discussion of Department-recommended regulatory amendments related to mammal trapping.
- Department lands. Initial vetting and discussion of Department-recommended regulatory amendments related to Department lands (ecological reserves and wildlife areas).
