

**California Fish and Game Commission**  
**Status of Marine Protected Area Petitions for Regulation Change Index**

*Revised February 10, 2026*

This index provides streamlined access to the 20 Marine Protected Area (MPA) petitions submitted to CFGC in November 2023, including those amended in January or March 2025. It also includes public comments received by CFGC regarding the active petitions. These petitions propose amendments to regulations governing California’s MPAs and/or changes to the MPA management program.

**Status Note:** In December 2024, CFGC acted on five of the MPA petitions following evaluation and recommendation from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), at the request of CFGC. For each of these five petitions, the proposed actions were either granted or denied, except for certain actions that were withdrawn by petitioners. A “granted” petition action indicates that CFGC has approved it for consideration in a future rulemaking process. The remaining 15 petitions and their proposed actions have been referred to CDFW for evaluation.

**Index Table:** The first column of the index table lists the “MPA Petition Tracking Number (No.)”, which links to the full petition and related materials. Petitions that have been amended are marked with “AM1” or “AM2” at the end of the tracking number. The last column of the table provides a link to a compilation of “Comments Received” since each petition was submitted to CFGC. This column contains either “N/A” or a range of dates: “N/A” indicates the petition was one of five considered by the Commission in 2024. Date ranges reflect the period for which public comments were received for the 15 petitions currently under CDFW review. Each date range entry in this column links to a PDF file containing comments compiled in chronological order. These files are updated following each CFGC meeting.
