- 1** Visit www.naspbai.org to set up an account. You will need to enter your school's information, too. For help in setting up your account contact: 608.633.1076.
- 2** Pick a day for your competition and gather your supplies (order paper targets). Order paper targets directly through NASP.
- 3** Visit the NASP All Tournaments website at: www.nasptournaments.org to register students. Click on California NASP Virtual State Archery Tournament.
- 4** Hold your tournament between January 4 and March 3.
- 5** Post your student scores online at the NASP All Tournament site by midnight March 3, 2016.



Students in Grades 4-12 that have received NASP archery lessons (in school) are eligible to compete. No other pre-qualification is necessary. See CalNASP tournament rules.

All students will be recognized for participation. Top boy and girl archer will receive a new Genesis Bow.

The State Tournament is a pre-qualifier for the NASP National Tournament held in Louisville, Kentucky in May.
