

Visitor Requirements and Use Restrictions

- **Registration is required** for area usage tracking. Registration may be completed with either:
 - a valid Lands Pass (season or single day), or
 - a valid hunting or fishing license.
- **All visitors must register** at parking Lot 14 prior to entering the public use areas.
- **Vehicles may only park** in parking lots 1 – 18 and may only be driven on Public Vehicle Access Routes.
- **Bicycles** are allowed on levees and main roads, but not on the Auto Tour Route or Hiking Trails.
- **Hours of use:** Sunrise to sunset, daily.
