
Fall and Winter Wildlife Observation Map

Visitor Requirements and Use Restrictions

- **Registration is required** for area usage tracking. Registration may be completed with either:
 - a valid Lands Pass (season or single day), or
 - a valid hunting or fishing license.
- **Fall and Winter Season** begins two weeks prior to the start of waterfowl hunting season and ends one week after the close of waterfowl hunting season (generally early October to mid-February).
- **All visitors must** register in parking lot 14. On **Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays** (designated hunt days), visitors **must** obtain a vehicle pass from the Wildlife Observation Window at the Check Station.
- **Vehicles may only** park in parking lots 14 – 18 and may only drive on designated Public Vehicle Access Routes.
- **Route Restrictions:**
 - Hiking or exiting vehicles is prohibited on the Auto Tour Route
 - Bicycling is prohibited on the Hiking Trail and Auto Tour Route during the Fall and Winter Season.
- **Hours of use:** Sunrise to Sunset, daily.
